

Glass Slumping Workshops

In the Studio at Roubaix House gallery there are opportunities to take part in cheerful Glass Slumping workshops with Michelle and David Walters. Lasting around one and a half hours, participants are shown how to decorate glass sheets to make their own slumped dishes, using colourful glass beads and other materials. Both the glass and the moulds are provided. No prior experience is needed. Be prepared to loose yourself in the creative process – you will not get dirty. Wine and other refreshments are served, depending on the time of day.

The cost of these workshops is R280 per person, and you will produce two glass dishes which you get to keep.

The kiln takes a day to fire and another to cool so collection and so the delivery of finished work will have to be arranged. A minimum of six people and maximum of ten can be catered for in each session. Groups welcome.
